Title I Parent’s Right to Know Letter

Dear Plato Family:

At Plato Learning Academy, we are very proud of our teachers and feel they are prepared to give your child a high-quality education. In accordance with ESEA Section 1111(h)(6) *PARENTS RIGHT-TO-KNOW*, we are notifying every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right and may request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child’s classroom teacher. This allows you to learn more about your child’s teachers’ training and credentials. We are happy to provide the following information in a timely manner should you request it:

- Whether the teacher met state qualifications and certification requirements for the grade level and subject he/she is teaching,
- Whether the teacher received an emergency or conditional certificate through which state qualifications were waived, and
- What undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, including graduate certificates and additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration.

You may also ask whether your child receives help from a paraprofessional. If your child receives this assistance, we can provide you with information about the paraprofessional’s qualifications.

Furthermore, if at any time your child has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by a non-highly qualified teacher, the school will notify you.

Our staff is committed to helping your child develop the academic knowledge and critical thinking he/she needs to succeed in school and beyond. That commitment includes making sure that all of our teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled and qualified.
