Dear Chicago Public Schools- ODLSS Families,

To support our students with disabilities, we must have our families as our thinking partners, with the intent of continuing our conversation related to serving those students.

Therefore, during the 2018-2019 school year, we will continue our efforts to support all families of students with disabilities through ongoing parent workshops and the ODLSS Parent Advisory Council (PAC).

In our attempts to empower families of students with disabilities, ODLSS will hold two "Parent Empowerment" Expos with the Mayor's Office for People with Disabilities (MOPD). We will host one in the Fall of 2018 and one in the Spring of 2019. At the Expos, our office will present special education experts to inform families about education rights, family supports, and post-secondary education strategies. Families will have an opportunity to consult with the experts about individual IEP's. We will also host monthly Parent University workshops across the District. Additionally, ODLSS has formed a Parent Advisory Council (PAC) during the 2017-2018 School Year. The ODLSS PAC will meet second Thursday of every month to advise our office.

In our efforts to provide high-quality instruction for our students, I hope that we continue our partnership to share ideas and information with parents, community partners, educational and professional experts. I believe that building relationships among the families and subject matter experts will allow for a more productive and happy life in our students' future endeavors.
