NWEA & Promotion

The final and most important NWEA test of the year is only a few weeks away. The Spring EOY will begin on Tuesday, May 15th and will take place at both campuses simultaneously.

This test is used for two purposes.

The first is for the school's annual SQRP score. This is only one metric, or measure, for the score but it is a considerable one. We are excited to share that we are closer than ever to reaching our goals! If we average 4 points in growth for Reading and 5 points in growth for Math, then we will be successful!

The second is for student promotion in grades 3, 6, and 8. We do follow the student promotion guidelines created by CPS so please see those should you have any questions. Simply put, students need to achieve a combination of NWEA scores AND grades throughout the year to be eligible for promotion. Otherwise, they will need to attend summer school for an additional opportunity to avoid retention.

This will be a topic of conversation at our upcoming meeting on Thursday, May 10th. We have already sent out warning letters to students who are in danger of being retained and will send out final confirmation letters no later than May 25th.

First PAC Meeting / Last Title I Meeting

One of our initiatives next year is the creation of a Parent Action Committee (PAC). We are looking for a few dedicated, impactful parents who are willing to not only be in attendance at these meetings but who are also willing to be a voice of both the school and the parents of our students.
