CPS recently released the district's SQRP scores and we are proud to announce that Plato Learning Academy experienced amazing growth.

Some of these impressive results include:

- Increasing from the 18th to the 42nd Percentile in Math Growth
- Increasing from the 3rd to the 63rd Percentile in Math Growth for our Diverse Learners
- Increasing from the 37th to the 95th Percentile in Math Growth for our 8th Graders
- Increasing from the 11th to the 85th Percentile in Reading for students in 4th Grade
- Improving our 5 Essentials

rating from Partially Organized to Organized (an increase of two ranks)

Way to go Plato staff and students!

Unfortunately, this growth only moved our raw score from a 2.1 to a 2.5 which means that we are still at a Level 2.

We are confident that we will be able to reach a raw score of 3.0, or a Level 2+, by the end of this year.
