On the final Friday of each month, we will be hosting a Character Counts driven Dress Down Day. Students are welcome to dress down and incorporate the color associated with the Pillar of the month. There will be, on occasion, other opportunities for your student to dress down as well. The following information pertains to <u>all</u> dress down days.

In order to participate, students must pay \$1 to their homeroom teacher at the beginning of class. Any student who arrives out of uniform and does not pay the fee will be in violation of our uniform policy. Please see the SCC for additional information.

We ask that you adhere to the following guidelines when participating in any dress down day.

- Jeans are permitted.
- Jeans with holes or rips on the legs are permitted but must have clothing underneath them.
- Jeggings, leggings, tights, or any other form fitting pants are not permitted.
- All shirts must have sleeves. Tank tops, off-the-shoulder, or cut-offs are not permitted.
- All shirts must completely cover the student's torso. Midriffs are not permitted.
- Shorts and skirts are permitted as long as they are at least finger-tip length.
- Coats, jackets, and hoodies are not permitted.
- No hats, bandanas, or do-rags are permitted.
- Clothing cannot reference any gang affiliation, drug/alcohol use, or any other adult themes.
