The following document outlines the compact between Plato Learning Academy and our parents.

1. The school will provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating student to meet the State's student academic achievement standards.
2. The school will hold parent-teacher conferences. These will be held on November 7th and April 10th for the 2018-2019 school year.
3. The school will provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. This will be through progress reports approximately at the mid-point of each quarter along with report cards following the conclusion of each quarter.
4. The school will provide parents access to staff. Parents are welcome to meet with teachers before school, after school, and during their prep time. We ask that parents schedule a meeting in advance whenever possible. Parents are also welcome to communicate with staff via e-mail and Remind.
5. The school will provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their children's classes. Parents who wish to volunteer must complete a volunteer packet including a background check prior to working with our students.

7. The parents will participate in decisions relating to the education of their children. This includes, but is not limited to, attending IEP meetings, participating in RTI conferences, and meeting with administration of the school.
