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Welcome to Hybrid Learning

Plato Family:

Thank you for entrusting Plato Learning Academy to begin providing in-person instruction to your students in a limited capacity beginning on February 1st. We ask that you read this letter in its entirety as it contains important information about the upcoming transition.

Hybrid learning is a combination of in-person instruction and remote learning. Under this model, students will attend school for two days per week - on Mondays and Tuesdays during our typical school hours. Students will return to remote learning for the remainder of the week. It is our hope that we will be able to expand the two days of in-person instruction to additional days as we continue into the school year.

The health and safety of our staff and students will be a critical factor during this time. Therefore, it is important that all students and their families attend a virtual session prior to returning to the school. These sessions will be held on Thursday mornings at 7:30 AM, starting January 7th, and on Monday evenings, starting January 11th, at 6:00 PM through the end of the month. Links for the sessions can be found on our website (www.platolearningacademy.org) and will be sent out via Remind and Dojo. Any families who do not attend a session will be moved to remote learning.

Families who have opted into hybrid learning can choose to return to remote learning at any point. We simply ask that you notify the school and complete the form indicating your decision. Families who have opted into remote learning, those who shift from hybrid to remote, or those who did not provide a response, will not be able to return to the school until the beginning of the 4th quarter, which begins on April 19th, if guidelines permit.

Finally, we ask that you continue practicing patience and understanding as we continue to navigate these complicated times. This transition will require time for our staff and students to adjust to adjusted processes and procedures within the school.
